



Statement of Public Compliance

- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland is committed to complying with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a meeting of the governing body.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* by a statement to that effect in its annual report.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland regularly monitors compliance with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland considers the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* when planning all fundraising activity.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland has a policy on working with third party fundraisers (if applicable).
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland has appointed a member of the governing body and/or a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public* and its implementation.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland has a feedback and complaints procedure

consistent with the *Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public*. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and governing body. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.

- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
- ✓ The Immigrant Council of Ireland is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
